## Who Qualifies?

Qualifying applicants must meet ALL 4 of the following eligibility requirements:

1

They are in one of these categories:

**Pregnant Women**  
through pregnancy and  
up to 6 weeks after birth  
or after pregnancy ends

**Breastfeeding  
Women**  
up to the infant's  
1<sup>st</sup> birthday

**Postpartum Women**  
who are not breastfeeding,  
up to 6 months after the  
birth of an infant or after  
pregnancy ends

**Infants and  
Children**  
up to their  
5<sup>th</sup> birthday
